VASILISSA



Brave and kind





Coals glimmer in its snapping maw







It mostly laughs at other's misfortune




It is usually brooding on some sort of wicked scheme

Not the smartest denizen of the woods, but he is kind and brave


He doesn't run, but floats. Zipping through the woods with amazing speed.




BABA YAGA'S HUT





Hidden behind branches and rocks there is a curious hut. A loud snoring sound can be heard coming from within....




Baba Yaga is a true hoarder and carries around more things that can fit in her hut.




The weather vane is wrought in the shape of a cauldron and chicken. Symbols of Baba Yaga/







A wind chime made with the bones of Baba Yaga's enemies. Its soft chimes can lull the unwary to sleep.




A homonculus carved from ginger.

They say that if you want to seek the aid of the witch you must leave a small fift and a not at one of these stones. She might just deign to help you! But at what price?




SEEKING BABA YAGA

The toads were kindly requested to sit elsewhere





POISON OF A VIPER
